

An intimate look at Bruce Cockburn, his life and his music

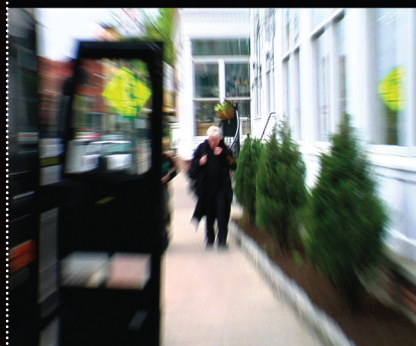
Pacing The Cage is a documentary that features Canadian singer/songwriter/activist Bruce Cockburn reflecting on his life and career. The documentary features appearances by songwriters Jackson Browne, Sylvia Tyson, Bono, Sarah Harmer, Colin Linden, best-selling authors Michael Ondaatje, William Young, Lt. Gen Romeo Dallaire and Bernie Finkelstein.

Pacing The Cage follows Bruce as he performs sold-out shows, records his live *Slice O' Life* album, and participates in a series of benefit concerts, featuring never-before-seen live performances of songs from his distinguished catalogue of music.

The documentary sheds new light on Bruce's spirituality and his thoughts on activism, politics, writing and his amazing 40-plus years in the music industry.
